



Watertown company in the 'Swim' Hopes to build on cartoon's success

Watertown animation studio Clambake Animation is working on a pilot for the Cartoon Network's "Adult Swim" programming block, and is waiting to hear if another, called "Southies," gets picked up.

The latest pilot is called "Tight Bros: Crushin It - All Up On You (The Beginning) Platinum Champagne Edition," or "Tight Bros," for short. Clambake founder and director of development Carl Adams describes it as "Entourage" without the money. Clambake has produced an animatic - a rough, thumbnail cartoon - and the pilot could air early next year.
